As we are more confined to our homes please stay in contact with us. I invite you to join us live for the following:

- Morning Mass at 9.00am each day
- ➤ Holy Hour on Friday at 7.30pm (Stations of the Cross & Adoration of Blessed Sacrament)
- Palm Sunday Mass with Blessing of Palms at 9.00am (Please have your own palms ready at home before the Mass)
- ➤ Penitential Celebration on Tuesday of Holy Week at 7.30pm (This is not the Sacrament of Reconciliation but a way of preparing ourselves spiritually for the celebration of the Triduum)
- ➤ Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.30pm followed by Adoration (This will include an invitation for families to participate in the Washing of the Feet at home at the appropriate time during this Mass.
- ➤ Good Friday Stations of the Cross at 10.00am
- ➤ Good Friday: The Passion of Our Lord at 3.00pm
- **Easter Vigil** on Saturday at 7.00pm
- **Easter Sunday Mass** at 9.00am

I want to encourage you to take a little time each day to reflect on the past day. When we are faced with so much troubling news we can sometimes lose sight of the graces and blessings that are also part of every day; the beauty of sunrise and sunset, the kindness people show us; unexpected graces in what can seem like a long day at home; the ways in which Jesus is present to us in the love we bear to one another as Christians.
