Homily

Examination of Conscience:

God is constantly searching for us. He celebrates us as His valuable treasure.

- How often do I remember that I am God's valuable treasure?
- Do I believe that God comes searching for me?
- Do I trust enough God's love for me?
- Do I revere God's presence in the Eucharist?
- Does the Eucharist have a place in my life?
- Do I believe and trust that God forgives me all my failings even before I ask for his pardon?

God patiently looks out and waits for me.

- How patient am I with myself, others and God?
- Have I been faithful to my personal prayer, sacrament of Reconciliation, the Holy Mass even when it seems my request is not granted?

• God celebrates me each time He finds me.

- In my relationship with others, do I show kindness, consideration and acceptance when they go through hard and bad times?
- Do I make efforts to befriend or welcome and include those who may feel left out in groups or family?
- Do I show kindness and respect for others?

Doing wrong is like being lost:

- Is God at the centre of choices that I make?
- Have I sometimes made wrong decisions?
- Have I made choices without thinking of their consequences and effects on my family or other people?
- How am I becoming a person of reconciliation?
- Is there someone in my life that I would need to search for and offer forgiveness?
- Is there someone in my life at this moment who is looking our for me and seeking forgiveness?

Do I pretend?

- Have I paid lip service to values that I proclaim but not a commitment of heart?
- Am I honest in my dealings with people and the values I uphold in public?
- Is my inner life congruent with the face I show to the public?
- Are the things I do and say for the purpose of outward approval?
- Do I offer help or do something nice for only those who would appreciate me?
- Am I able to reach out to those who are forgotten by the society?
