MESSAGE FROM FR DENIS:

Dear Parishioners,
Seven years ago, on 20th January 2016, our parish was established with the new St Thomas the Apostle Parish, Clyde North, being separated from St Agatha’s Parish, Cranbourne. We have celebrated that Parish Foundation Day at Masses on Friday in this past week.
We look forward now to establishing ourselves in our new parish church. During the past week we received some frustrating news in that an ongoing delay with one of the service providers has meant that we have confirmed with the builders and architects that we will not be able to celebrate the Dedication Mass for our new church on Sunday 19th February, as we had advertised before Christmas. It is disappointing. The delay is expected to be a matter of a few weeks only, so we anticipate being in the new church by late February or early March.
In discussion with Bishop Greg, we now are looking forward to a Mass of Dedication on Sunday 23rd April in the joy of the Easter season.
I remain grateful for the amazing generosity of our parishioners, and I ask you to continue to pray for the safe and successful completion of this major project in the parish. St Thomas the Apostle, pray for us. Fr Denis

BIOGRAPHY OF DEACON MICHAEL: Michael is an Anglo-Indian, the youngest of 11 children, all born in Madras India. He migrated to the UK with his parents Bernard and Marjorie Manuel in the late 70’s, living in London and working as a Civil Servant with various Government departments while also studying law, eventually being admitted to practice in England. Michael migrated to Australia with his wife Pam (and their children Rebecca and Catherine) in late 1999, initially living in Cranbourne (attending St. Agatha’s parish, where both girls were confirmed) before moving to the Narre Warren parish of Our Lady Help of Christians in April 2007. His interest in the Permanent Diaconate began and was encouraged since late 2010 by the late Fr. John Allen, then Parish Priest at Narre Warren. Michael’s journey to ordination has longer than usual, with the loss of two Bishop’s to other Arch-dioceses. Michael completed pastoral placement at the Warragul and St. Michael’s, Berwick and he was ordained on 16.12.2022 at St. Michael’s. He was appointed to St. Thomas’, Clyde North on 1.1.2023.

Michael and Pam celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary last December. Rebecca & Catherine are both married: Catherine now lives in the Czech Republic with her husband Pavel while Rebecca and her husband Jan live in Melbourne with their two children, Alexander (7) & Annika (5) whom Pam and Michael absolutely dote on. Alexander and Annika spend time with them regularly each weekend.

Michael is a Solicitor by profession, having been in practice in the U.K. and since 2001 in Australia. He is still in practice on a part-time basis with a local practice in Cranbourne West. He looks forward to working with the people of God at Clyde North, and asks you keep him in your thoughts and prayers for his ministry at St. Thomas the Apostle.
