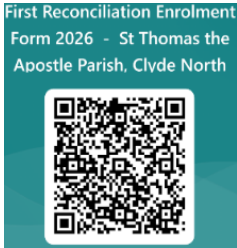

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS 2025-2026.- Rite of Sending and Rite of Election, 22nd February - The catechumen and candidates will re-commence their RCIA weekly sessions on **2nd February**. We ask our parish community to continue holding them in prayer as they progress in their spiritual journey towards the **Rite of Sending** in our church and the **Rite of Election** at **St Mary’s Cathedral**. The **Rite of Sending** is the moment when our parish affirms that a catechumen or candidate is ready to take the next step toward entering the Catholic Church, and sends them forth to the bishop with confidence in their readiness. The **Rite of Election** is a joyful celebration in which the Church, along with godparents and sponsors representing the parish, publicly acknowledges the participants’ readiness to become fully Catholic at Easter. At this rite, **Bishop Greg** will formally recognise them as the **Elect**. From this moment onward, they are no longer catechumens but *Elect*, chosen to enter the final period of preparation for the sacred mysteries to be celebrated at Easter.
